RENOWNED CHEF A PRIZE CATCH FOR SEAFOOD FESTIVAL

THE Apollo Bay Seafood Festival will sail into town this weekend with star chef Jacques Reymond at the helm.

In its fifth year, the festival showcases the best of the region's seafood.

Chef Reymond said between the "sea breeze, waves and beaches" the event will offer visitors the chance to "taste and explore the exceptional produce of the beautiful region".

Festival-goers will be treated to a cooking demonstration by the acclaimed chef, along with live entertainment, market stalls and an abundance of local seafood.

The State Government last week awarded \$50,000 in stimulus funding to the Great Ocean Road communities to help the region bounce back after the devastating bushfire on Christmas Day and some of that cash will go towards the event. Festivities will kick off on Friday night with a special pre-festival event held on the foreshore, before the official opening on Saturday.
