CRUSADERS OF THE KEG

KEG kings Leigh Bridges and Bobby Henry got on a roll and rode it to a fighting finish in the nation's inaugural Keg Rolling Competition at the weekend.

The competition was part of the third annual Great Australian Beer Festival in Geelong, which showcased more than 200 Australian

craft beers and ciders. More than 40 brewers from far and wide compete in a series of heats to be quickest to roll a keg, any way they could, 50m to the finish line on Geelong racecourse. Controversially, a cider maker, Carl Triglia from Two Many Chiefs, took out the overall title of Keg Rolling Champion.
